


Date and Time of Imagery

Using the [Location Tool](#), you can find out the date and time at which Nearmap imagery of a specific location was captured.

To determine the date and time of imagery at any location:

1. Select the Location tool:
 - a. New MapBrowser - from the toolbar at the top of the screen
 - b. MapBrowser Classic - from the toolbar at the side of the screen (pin icon)
2. Click anywhere on the map. The **Location panel** will open.
3. The **Photo time** field tells you the exact date and time at which the image was captured (AEDT).

 Note: The survey date may differ from the actual capture date of the image, as explained in [Survey Date and Photo Time](#).

You can change the date in the [Date Selection Tool](#) to find out the capture times of previous surveys as well.
