

# MapBrowser Loads With the Wrong Basemap

When you log into MapBrowser, a new MapBrowser session will always open with the URL from the close of the last session, unless you use a specific URL to launch MapBrowser.

The exception to this is if 3D is your saved (and hence persisted) base layer, on a tablet device it will default to the Vertical base layer.

The URL contains all the location information of your current view. You can learn more about this here: [About the MapBrowser URL](#).

So if you are concerned that your base layer is not defaulting to, say, Vertical, it's because when you last signed out you were viewing a different base layer.

You can always save a view by one of these three methods:

- bookmarking the URL
- sharing the URL
- creating a Project. The Project saves your last view characteristics also. Find out more here: [Projects Tool](#)
